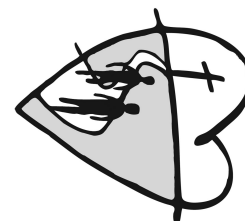
A very Special Sunday, December 27 Steve Foxworth

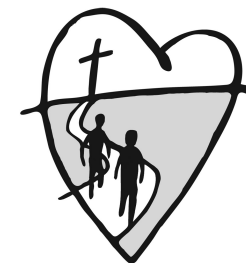
