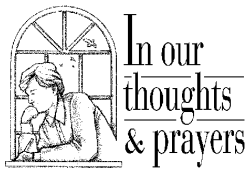

We want to thank you for your prayers for us. We experienced such an answer on Monday, January 4.

We left Guatemala City in the early afternoon to return home. After traveling about two miles in the city, a car pulled beside us having three men with guns who demanded that we pull over. One man with a pistol entered the passenger side beside Glynis and another into the driver side, pushing me into the back seat. We were driven for 10-15 minutes into an obscure area of the capital where they demanded that we get out of our truck and get into their car. After getting into their car, we were driven for several more minutes with pistols to our sides and our heads down until we came to an obscure alley where they told us to "Get out and go home!" We exited the car, and they drove away.

We were amazed at the peace the Lord gave us during the whole time. The Lord reminded us that what we have taught and preached for some many years is real. Today, we are regrouping and getting back to the task of bringing the Gospel to Guatemala. Robbers may take our possessions, but they cannot touch our purpose for being here and our determination to fulfill God's call on our lives.
